Reflections..... On the Seasons

There was a man who had four sons. He wanted his sons to learn not to judge things too quickly. So he sent them each on a quest, in turn, to go and look at a pear tree that was a great distance away. The first son went in the winter, the second in the spring, the third in summer, and the youngest son in the fall.



When they had all gone and come back, he called them together to describe what they had seen.

The first son said that the tree was ugly, bent, and twisted. The second son said that no, it was covered

with green buds and full of promise.

The third son disagreed; he said it was laden with blossoms that smelled so sweet and looked so beautiful, it was the most graceful thing he had ever seen.

The last son disagreed with all of them; he said it was ripe and drooping with fruit, full of life and fulfillment.

The man then explained to his sons that they were all right, because they had each seen but only one season in the tree's life. He shared that you cannot judge a tree, or a person, by only one season, and that the essence of who they are - the pleasure, the joy, and love that come from their life - can only be measured at the end, when all the seasons are up.

If you give up in the midst of winter, you will miss

fulfillment of your fall. So don't let the pain of one season destroy the joy of all the rest. Do not judge life by one difficult season. If you can persevere through the difficult patches, better times are sure to come...

There is a reason that the church year begins with the season of Advent. It is a time both of looking back, and of looking ahead. It is a time of renewed Hope for the future, and a season of new direction and growth.



I am reminded of, and take comfort in, Jesus words: "I will be with you, even to the end." He does not promise that life will be easy, or full of happiness, or filled with reward. Those things, and many others, will come at the end of our journey. So no matter what season you find yourself in – know that it is only a season, and that Christ awaits us with open arms. That's something worth celebrating – wouldn't you agree?


