

Some people have inquired v contents are determined by pa preparation, and cost effectiveness. Each backpack of lunch, a Kraft Easy Mac (micro Drink mix (no artificial sweets saccharin...), a sweet snack(of Treats, Snack Pack Pudding, e

salty snack (could include Goldfish, Cheez-its, Pirates Booty, Pretzels, etc.), Pop-Tart Bites (regular Pop-Tarts break and crumble), applesauce or peach cups, peanut butter, jelly, Cocoa Mix (in cool weather), and individual servings of Kellogg's Cereal. We don't include cans because the bags get too heavy and they crush other foods. We don't use juice boxes or pouches because they can puncture and leak.

Chips are easily crushable, but may be used on occasion.

Packing happens on the first Monday of each month, with the exception of September - which is the first Tuesday. We begin at 3:00 in the lobby in the back of the church off the Family Life Center and are typically done by 4:00.
